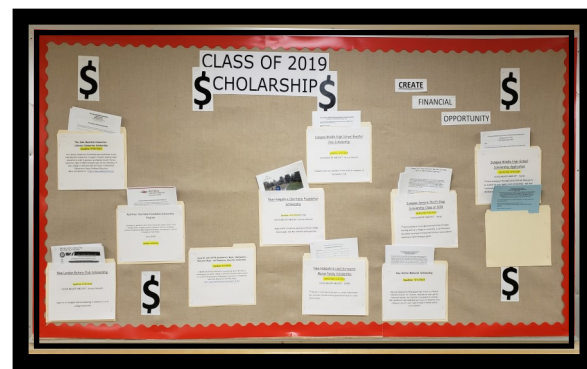
SENIORS

TESTING INFORMATION

SAS

8th grade students and juniors can expect a spring assessment in science. There will be more to come on specific dates in the next Guidance News and Notes.

New Hampshire students in **grades 3-8 and 11** will take the common statewide assessment for English language arts (ELA)/writing and mathematics.

⇒ **Grades 3-8** students will take the new NH Statewide Assessment System for ELA/writing and mathematics.

⇒ **Grade 11** (March 27th) students will continue to take the College Board School Day SAT.

Advanced Placement tests will take place in May. Posted schedule:
