End of the year testing is well underway with juniors completing their SAT's and Science assessments last month. AP testing began immediately following the April vacation. Here is a snapshot at what remains:

FINALS SCHEDULE

The finals are scheduled for June 8th – June 11th. The Middle School will continue on a normal seven period schedule during the exam period. The High School schedule is as follows:

- ◆ High school student attendance is only required for periods when students have exams, beginning Tuesday June 8th.
- ◆ Exam grades will count as follows (credit is only offered for passing final averages):

Semester Course

- 1st marking period = 45%
- 2nd marking period = 45%
- Exam = 10%**

Year Long Course

- 1st marking period = 22.5%
- 2nd marking period = 22.5%
- Exam = 5%**
- 3rd marking period = 22.5%
- 4th marking period = 22.5%
- Exam = 5%**

- ◆ Students who are tardy more than 5 minutes will not be allowed to take the exam during the scheduled period.
- ◆ Any student who is absent during an exam period must have a parent (guardian) call the school before 9:00 a.m. on the day of the absence. No make-up exam will be allowed without the permission of the administration.
- ◆ Students must stay in the room for the entire exam period.
- ◆ Students on the school grounds who do not have an exam period must be in the cafeteria or library, both of which will be quiet areas. Only students who have a make-up exam should be on school property after lunch.
- ◆ Lunch will be provided for high school students at 11:30 each day during the exam period.
- ◆ Students must turn in their books or pay for lost books before taking the exam.
