SENIORS a reminder that when you are prepared to apply to college, you will need to notify your guidance counselor in advance and make an appointment to finalize and send your application.


You will need:

- The application.
- The fee payable by check or preferably a credit card to enter electronically with online applications.
- A completed essay.
- To send your SAT and/or ACT scores electronically, if necessary
- An updated transcript.
- A teacher recommendation. This is typically held on file in the guidance office assuming prior notice was given to each teacher, or submitted electronically.

Guidance staff will:

- Make sure the application is complete, make copies, and file appropriate paperwork. Often times applications come back incomplete due to filing issues on the receiving end. Our records help us meet the required application expectations in a timely fashion as these instances occur.
- Provide a School Report and recommendation. •
- Provide a School Profile. •
- Mail supplemental information. •
- Provide an updated transcript as requested by the receiving institutions. •
- Complete mid-year and final reports.
